14 th August 2025	Nodor House Replacement	In February 2025, the landlord exercised the break clause in the lease agreement giving formal notice requiring South Wales Police to vacate the property by August 2026. A new facility was identified to accommodate staff members and all storage requirements at a cost of £190,000 p.a.	Approved
14 th August 2025	VPRU Policy and Project Support Officer	The role funded from a Home Office Grant will provide dedicated project and policy support to ensure effective planning, delivery and monitoring of place-based activity aimed at tackling serious violence, antisocial behaviour and community harm.	Approved
11 th September 2025	VPR Comms and Engagement Officer	The post will be a fixed term for 12 months supporting the Violence Prevention Unit to fulfil actions relating to the Police, Crime and Justice Plan, focussing on engagement and communications that relate to crime prevention and violence reduction.	Approved
22 nd September 2025	Revised Comms and Engagement Budget Request	Revised budget proposal request relating to revisions of the Comms and Engagement activities including digital/content creation. This will support the Commissioner's statutory duties to engage with the public and in part address a thematic issue within the Police, Crime and Justice Plan relating to inclusivity and accessibility.	Approved



22 nd September 2025	Children Young Persons Police Crime and Justice Resource	This 2-year finance funding proposal will support the co-ordination and delivery of the Children's and Young People Police, Crime and Justice Plan.	Approved
22 nd September 2025	Substance Use Commissioned Services	The contract for the Substance Misuse Offender Intervention Service delivered by Dyfodol will end on 31 March 2026. From April 2026, services in Cwm Taf Morgannwg and Cardiff & Vale will be jointly funded by South Wales and HMPPS. This will be for a five-year period.	Approved
4 th November 2025	Hosting and Support Package for PCC Website	The website is hosted and supported by Everglow, and the annual support package is due for renewal in December 2025. It is recommended to maintain the same level of service support, security reassurance and protection for consistency at an annual cost of £2,695 with shared VPS hosting at £770 per year.	Approved
13 th February 2026	Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women (CEDAW)	A UN delegation for this Convention will be visiting Wales in March 2026 and PCCs have been for their support by contributing £1,500. This Conference will provide PCCs with an opportunity to highlight the work of Policing in Wales to tackle gender discrimination and violence against women and girls.	Approved
17 th February 2026	Cardiff Central Design Proposals	The Cardiff Central proposals and roadmap pave the way to allow for an improved facility that will serve operational police and the night-time economy.	Approved
